## CHILDREN'S LANDSCAPE

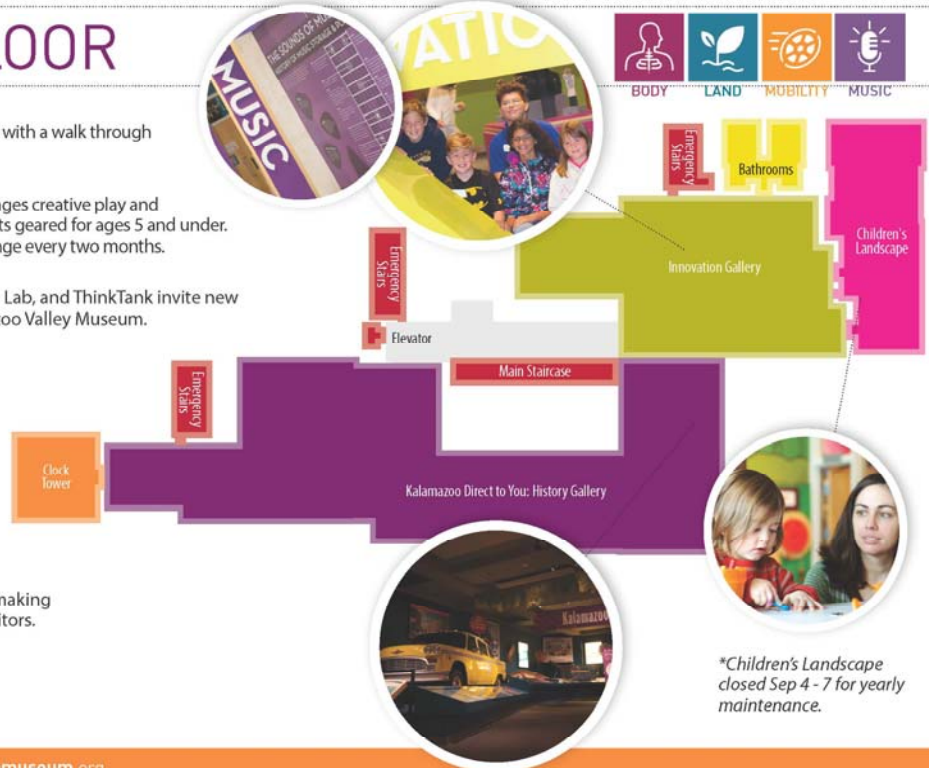
This special area for preschoolers encourages creative play and provides programs and interactive exhibits geared for ages 5 and under. The themed activities and programs change every two months.
